



### **2010 Pinot Noir, La Combe Verte**

La Combe Verte means "The Green Fault" or "The Green Valley" and was named for the amazing team at Patricia Green Cellars. Without their help we would still be sorting grapes from the 2009 vintage! Essentially, it is Patricia Green Cellar's "fault" that we were able to start this project.

This wine is a blend of old vine vineyards from throughout the Willamette Valley with an average vine age of over 25 years. It spends 11 months in French Oak barrels with 15% new oak. The wine is lightly filtered, no fining prior to bottling.
