



2011 Pinot Blanc, Crannell Vineyard

Sitting on the east ridge of the Eola-Amity hills lies a small vineyard owned by the Crannell family. It overlooks the Willamette Valley with Mount Hood in the distance, perched perfectly to enjoy the morning sun. We have sourced grapes from this vineyard for a number of years now and each year Ken falls in love with the Pinot Blanc from his blocks. The 2011 vintage was no different, with the fruit coming in perfectly ripe with stunning acidity and pure fruit notes showing peach, Meyer lemon and a touch of apple. Aromatics are what really make you pay attention to the wine however, with floral notes of apple blossom, orange blossom and a texture to the palate that is weighty, but clean with the acidity racing through the finish. This was a selection of our favorite barrels from the Crannell Vineyard this harvest and is arguably the best white wine from Walter Scott yet.
