



2013 Pinot Noir, Cuvée Ruth, Willamette Valley

Cuvée Ruth is a Reserve Barrel selection that we craft each vintage to represent the character of the season. With the 2013 vintage some of our best vineyard sites make up this Pinot Noir, including Freedom Hill, Eola Springs and Bieze Vineyards. The wine is elegant and polished, with both red and black fruit notes layered with the power and depth Freedom Hill Vineyard is famous for.

The wine is a blend of Pommard, Wadenswill and Dijon clones, fermented with indigenous yeasts and aged for 14 months in French oak barrels with 30% of them new. The wine is unfinned and unfiltered.

Cuvée Ruth was created in 2012 as a bridge between the Willamette Valley Pinot Noir and the Single Vineyards. It is a wine dedicated to the memory of Ruth and Irv Kantor, Our partner Sue's parents, showing tribute to Sue & Andy for helping us realize our dreams.
