



2015 Chardonnay, Freedom Hill Vineyard, Willamette Valley, Oregon

The Dusschee Family has been growing Chardonnay longer than most, putting lots of care into growing the best fruit possible. In 2012 we were lucky enough to start working with their fruit, getting access to one acre of Chardonnay and one acre of Pinot Noir. After many years working with this vineyard alongside Mark Vlossak, Ken was thrilled.

Mark used to say this site was very 'Chablis-like'. We are starting to agree... The wine has delicate aromas of fennel, yellow flowers and mixed citrus. The palate is all finesse; with juicy acidity and a long minerally finish.

This wine was fermented and aged in a new Puncheon and four neutral barrels for 11 months with 100% native yeast fermentation and minimal bâtonnage. The wine was blended and finished in stainless steel for an additional 3 months.
